RESOLUTION NO. 11 OF 2024

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TOWN TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT
FOR THE PERIMETER FENCING PROJECT AT THE HART AIRPORT**

WHEREAS, the Town desires to engage in construction activities on Town property in connection with the Perimeter Fencing Project at Hart Airport, designated as Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) AIP No. 3-22-0030-018-2024 (the “Project”), pursuant to design plans and specifications prepared by KSA Engineers, Inc. (“Engineers”); and,

WHEREAS, the Town has received competitive bids based on the construction plans and specifications prepared by Engineers; and,

WHEREAS, Engineers have evaluated the bids and qualifications of the contractors that have submitted a bid to perform the work described in the construction plans and specifications; and,

WHEREAS, Engineers recommend that the contract for construction of the Project be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder on the basis of the low bid submitted together with such alternates as may be funded through the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the funds required to complete the Project will be provided by grants from the FAA and LaDOTD Aviation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MANY, LOUISIANA:

§1. The Town enter into a contract with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the Project.

§2. The Mayor is authorized and empowered to execute said contract, to execute change orders as provided in the contract, and to execute any and all documents necessary to complete the Project and to do any and all things necessary and proper to carry out this Resolution and to fulfill its objects and purposes.

§3. The Mayor is authorized and empowered to execute all grant offers, conveyance instruments, including purchase agreements, acts of sale, acts of donation, rights of way or servitude agreements, related to the Project, and to execute any and all other documents necessary to complete the Project, and do any and all things necessary and proper to carry out this Resolution and to fulfill its objects and purposes.

§4. This Resolution shall become effective upon final adoption and signature of the Mayor.

Said Resolution having been read and considered by a quorum of the Town Council, on motion to adopt by Darwin, seconded by Brocato, a record vote was taken and the following result was had:
